Who Qualifies?

If you are 16 years of age or over and meet the following requirements, it is possible for you to serve as a volunteer summer staff member at Ironwood for the summer of 2012.

1. Complete the application process. (Applications will be mailed in January.)
2. Successfully finish the week of training (May 28–June 2 or July 2–7).
3. Be accepted by the Ironwood camp administration.
4. Agree to a \$15 a week honorarium.
5. Commit to a definite period of service (May 28–July 7 or July 2–August 4).

Participation in this program will help you to understand the biblical principles of servant leadership.
